

Microsoft PowerPoint – 2013 Version in OS X El Capitan

How to Add a Video to a Presentation to Start Automatically

Step 1

First, open up your Microsoft PowerPoint Presentation Program

Click on File and Open a Powerpoint (New or Existing)

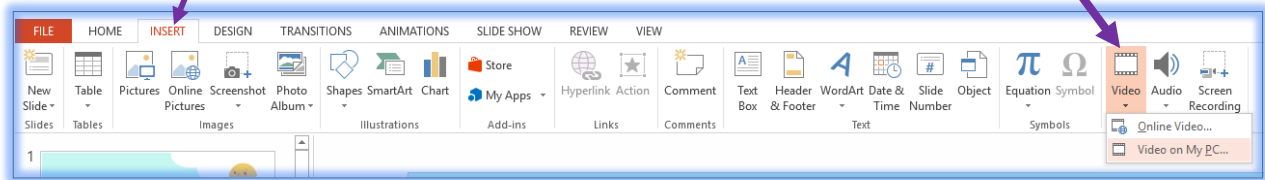


Step 2

In PowerPoint, to Add a Video to your Presentation, You would start by clicking the INSERT Tab

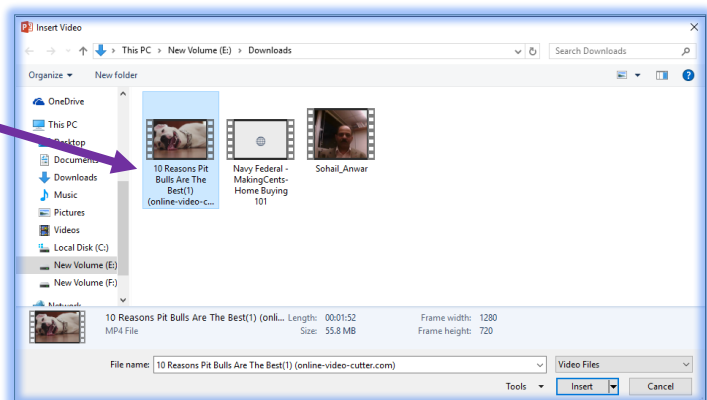
Click on the VIDEO button to choose a file from your PC

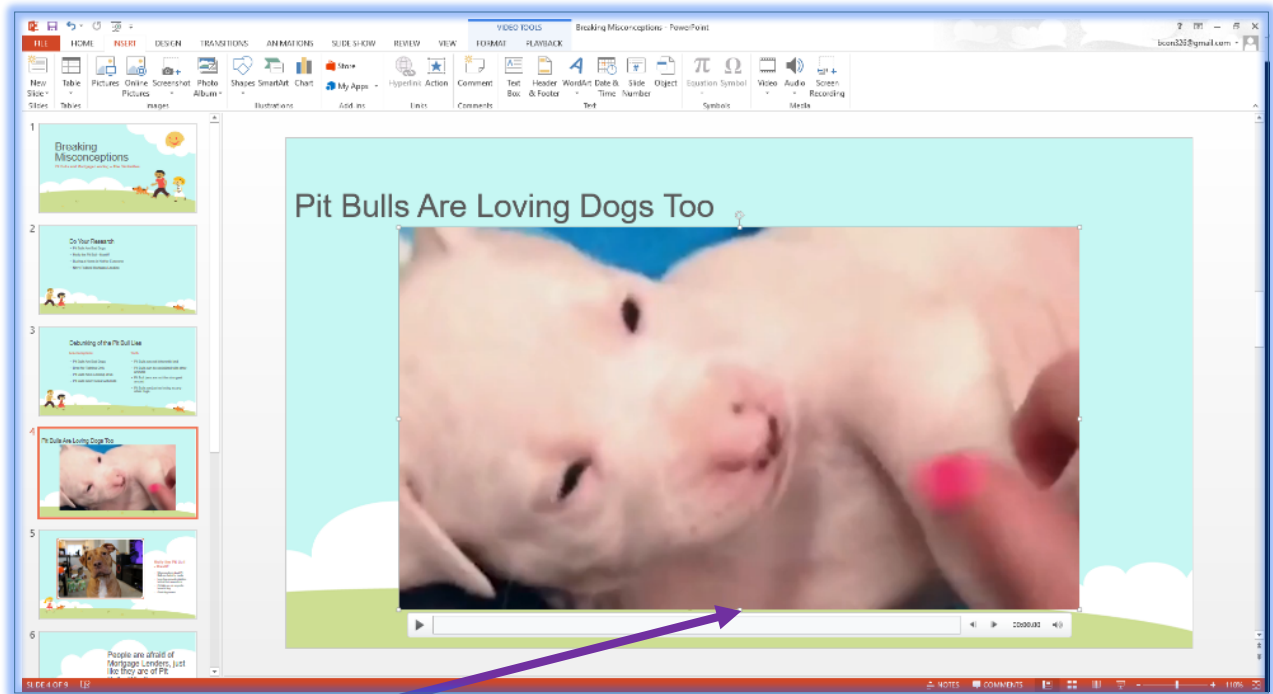
Step 3



Choose the video file that you would like to add to your PowerPoint (In this case, I am adding a video called “10 Reasons Pit Bulls Are The Best”)

Step 4



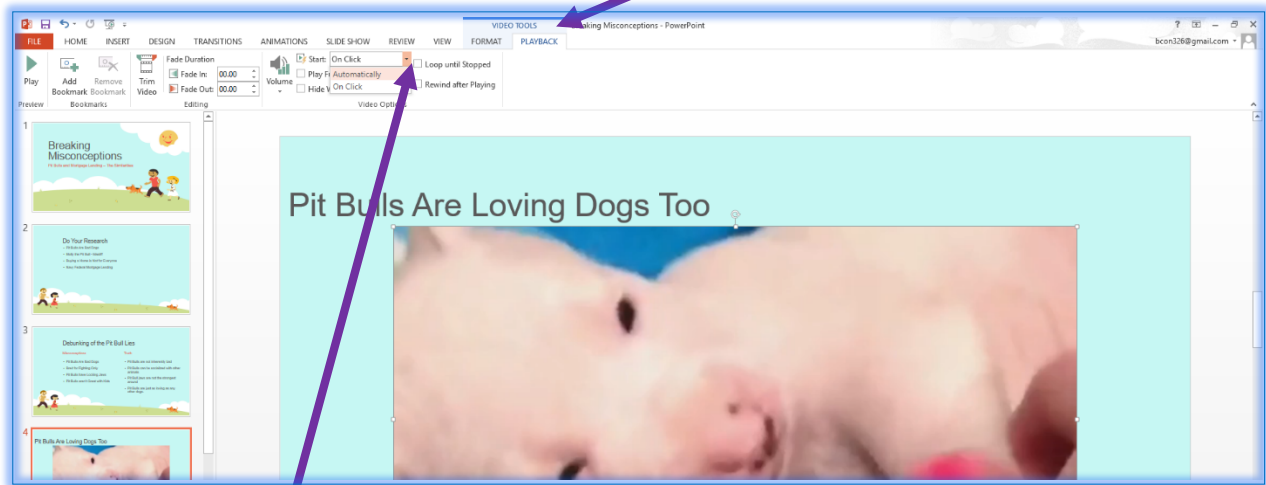


The Video will be added to your Slide and you can format the size of the video that you prefer.

Step 5

While you are still clicked on the video, at the top of the screen, click on the PLAYBACK Tab

Step 6



Step 7

Click the Drop down menu that says "On Click" and choose "Automatically". This will enable your video to start upon presentation.
